FACILITIES

- St Albert Community hall, 17 Perron St. St Albert
- This is an indoor facility. No indoor benching.
- Parking is to the rear of the building or on the front street. The front side small parking lot is reserved for Judges.
- Please pick up after your dog.
- There are washrooms for use downstairs and water onsite.
- For those unable to maneuver downstairs there is access to an upstairs washroom.
- There will be a backdrop set up for picture taking in the front foyer.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- 1) Classes are judged by a C-WAGS judge and trial results are submitted at the end of the trial.
- 2) Handlers who are physically challenged are allowed and encouraged to compete. In this facility the upper main hall has the only access for those not able to maneuver stairs.
- 3) Awards: C-WAGS ribbons will be awarded to every dog/handler team who successfully qualifies in a class. C-WAGS does not offer placement ribbons. Title ribbons will be available for teams who have successfully completed four runs under 2 judges at the same level.
- 4) Gift bags for those that receive the best score per class.
- 5) Times will be posted in the front foyer. Best times will be announced during reset break and Judges break.
- 6) Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.
- 8) Anyone observed giving up hide locations will be immediately excused from the trial rounds and will forfeit entry fees, and any titles gained at that trial.
- 7) **Refunds: No refunds within 3-days prior of a trial date.**
- 8) RULES and CLASS DESCRIPTIONS For a complete description of the C-WAGS rules, regulations, performance guidelines explanation of levels www.c-wags.org.
- 9) **It is YOUR responsibility to understand all rules.**
- 10) A valid registration into the trials includes the completed entry form and signed waiver with payment.
- 11) Any fees not received within 7 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries.
- 12) No reinstatement of results is possible.

Schedule:

- a. **Check in is 5:30 pm until 6:00 pm**
(We are accommodating, let the host know if you are going to be late. You still need to make your entered class before all runs in that class are completed.)
 - b. The runs will begin between **6:00 - 6:15 pm.**
- Searches will run consecutively and simultaneously with breaks taken for changes.
 - Running order will be posted.
 - Run times with Qualifiers or Non-Qualifiers will be posted.

Your DOG/S:

- 1) All breeds of dogs and mixed breeds are eligible to compete in C-Wags events.
- 2) Dogs must be at least six months of age to compete.
- 3) Dogs that are physically challenged are allowed and encouraged to compete, providing they do not show evidence of being in pain or discomfort. The Judge shall excuse any dog that is in pain or discomfort during the competition. A Judge has the final decision.
- 4) Sorry No female dogs in season will compete. Refunds will be made for females in season upon written request accompanied by a statement from the exhibitor's veterinarian. Handlers should contact the trial secretary at least 3 days prior to the trial if they anticipate that their dog may be in season.
- 5) There is no use of corrective collars in the facility. Please make sure they are not on your dog when you enter the building.
- 6) Dogs must be on leash when on the show site unless running in the trial where it is permitted.
- 7) Dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans shall be excused from competition at the discretion of either the Judge or the Trial Host. If the Trial Host believes it is necessary in order to ensure the safety of others, he or she shall request that the dog be removed from the showgrounds or confined in such a manner as to remove the threat to others. No refund.
- 8) No dogs inside the facility unless, in que, or running, or permitted to bench when volunteering at the trial that night.
- 9) Anyone observed disciplining their dog in a manner that offends a judge's sensibilities will be excused and will forfeit entry fees.
- 10) If running 2 dogs, each dog may not run in the same class unless resets of that class are offered for that class. If resets are offered for second dogs, the second dog will run last.
- 11) C-Wags registration Number: All dogs entered must be registered with C-Wags.
Dogs may register with C-WAGS up to the day of the trial.

- 12) Please do not use crumbly or messy food in the ring. This could result in a NQ if you drop food in the ring. Reward next to the hide not above to avoid drool or other contaminants.
- 13) Move Ups will be allowed. Same fees occur for each move up. E-transfers will be accepted that same night. If you title, you may move up a class but only in a new round. Example: if you title in Round one you cannot move up a class in round one but must wait until the class you want to move up into is in another round. If you do run your dog in the class, you already paid for, you must pay for an additional run for your move up.

Definitions:

“Aggressive Behavior” means that the Dog has attacked or threatened to attack.

“Dog” means any dog, or dogs, at the event with the Releasers whether participating or not.

“Event” means seminar.

“Hazards” mean and include, but are not limited to, the condition of the grounds, floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, parking areas, wooded areas, fields, wildlife and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people.

“Loss” means any damage or injury (including death).

Certification

I certify that:

1. I am the Owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized Handler of the Dog.
2. I have read, understand, and will abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Releases in effect at the time of the Event.
3. The Dog does not have a history of Aggressive Behavior and is not a danger to persons or other dogs.

Acknowledgment

I acknowledge that:

1. Attendance at or participation in the Event will expose the Dog and myself to a number of Hazards which could result in Loss to the Dog or to myself.
2. There is a risk of Loss to the Dog caused by its attendance at or participation in the Event, including but not limited to, Loss caused by the premises, equipment, other dogs, and other people.
3. There is a risk of Loss to myself and other persons in attendance with me caused by my attendance at or participation in the Event, including but not limited to, Loss caused by the premises, equipment, other dogs, and other people.

Release

In consideration of the acceptance of my application for attendance at or participation in the Event, I hereby:

1. Release the Releasees from all nature of liability, including liability for negligence, whether gross negligence or otherwise, arising from my attendance at or participation in the Event, and freely assume all risks, including the risk of injury to my person, my property or the Dog, which may occur because of my attendance at or participation in the Event.
2. Release the Releasees from all liability of any nature, including liability for negligence, whether gross negligence or otherwise, for all loss, in relation to claims against me or through me, or against or through any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending as my guest or in my place, or arising as a result of any action or

inaction by me or by the Dog, or its Owner or Handler, or by any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending the Event as my guest or otherwise. I expressly assume all responsibility and liability for all such claims.

Indemnity

In further consideration of the acceptance of my application for attendance at or participation in the Event, I hereby agree to indemnify the Releases for any costs whatsoever, including legal costs, that the Releases' may incur because of, or which may arise, or be attributed to my attendance at or participation in, or the attendance at or participation of the Dog in, the Event.
