

PRECISION SEARCH DOG®

3-Day Scenario-Based Training Event

- This workshop is designed for Human Remains Detection (HRD) teams looking to refine their and their dog skills in realistic- scenarios. The training like to search profile is for the serious.
- Training will focus on low threshold sources, aged sources, historical burials, and search strategies. PLUS: Introduction, refresher to shoreline water search training plus water theory.
- Participants will also take part in night training to enhance their ability to work in low-light conditions.
- The event includes hands-on practical work, ensuring that each team gains valuable experience in various search environments.
- Only handlers with HRD training with a Trained Final Response are accepted.

Participation is limited to eight handler-dog teams to allow for personalized instruction and maximum training time.

Each dog team will be given at least one clean environment, meaning no other dog team contaminations present, scenario.

- Working time will be long so prepare your dog to be working a minimum of 1 hour at a time. Be prepared to work on your own and understand search strategy, handling of evidence, false alerts, etc.
- We will travel to a location away from the Morinville area. At this location we will have a BBQ.

To get your imagination flowing, here are a few of the scenarios you will be working: Evidence Search / Abduction / Fire Scene/ Serial Dumping Ground (mock search exercise).

- Must have a trained indication or alert on human remains source.
- Obedience controlled
- Any gear you need for your dog to wear.
- Healthy
- If your dog does not like other dogs or persons within their bubble, please let everyone know.
- Females will be worked last through areas if they are in heat. Protective undergarments will be mandatory.

This workshop will provide training in historical remains with as realistic scenarios as possible.
